Sadly the static's are one in seven women will develop this disease and we need a Dr. like you. We need you!

If there is anyway you can keep the insurance going I hope you do, there are so many of us that truly need a Dr. like you and your marvelous staff.

Sandy thanks for making this process sp much easier for me. As you know I had about 18 surgeries before I saw you. Just one from you and I am complete again.
