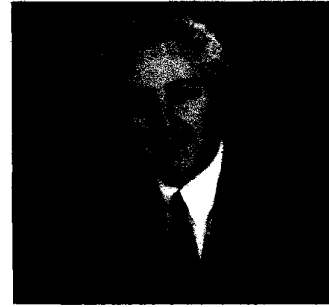


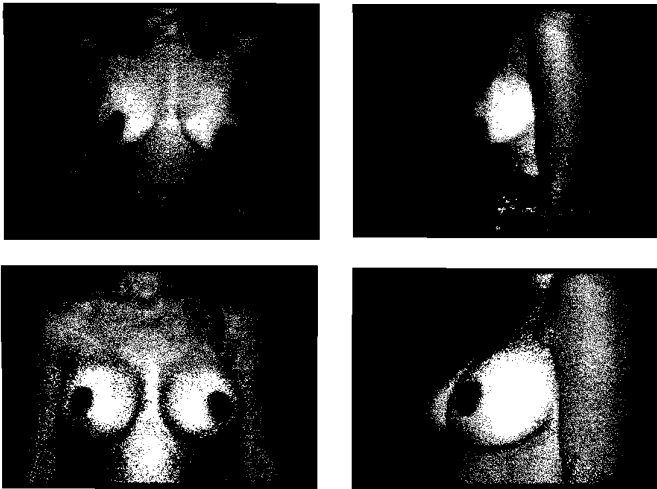
Breastlift

The Invisible Scar Technique

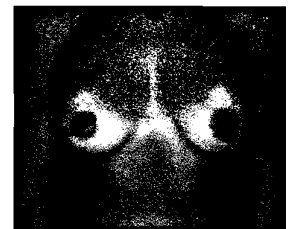
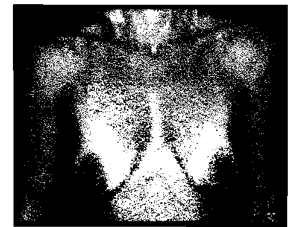


One of the major factors deterring a woman from undergoing breastlift surgery is the resultant scarring. A new technique has been developed by Dr. Hilton Becker that reduces scarring to a minimum. In many cases scars become virtually imperceptible. An incision is made around the edge of the areola allowing the breast to be lifted internally. As all tightening is done internally, no sutures are required on the skin incision. Dr Becker has published his new technique "The Dermal Overlap Subareolar Mastopexy" in *Aesthetic Surgery*, September/October 2001. He has also presented his technique at the 'Reconstruction After Mastectomy Symposium' in Ancona, Italy, September 2001, 'The Ontario Society of Plastic Surgeons Scientific Session' Canada, October 2001, 'The American Society For Aesthetic Plastic Surgery' (ASAPS), New York, New York, May 2001.
